The children have been working on their number recognition 1-10 and matching the numbers with the correct amount and we have been working on counting backwards from 10-1.

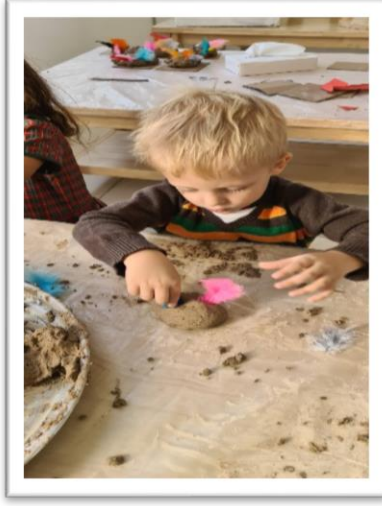
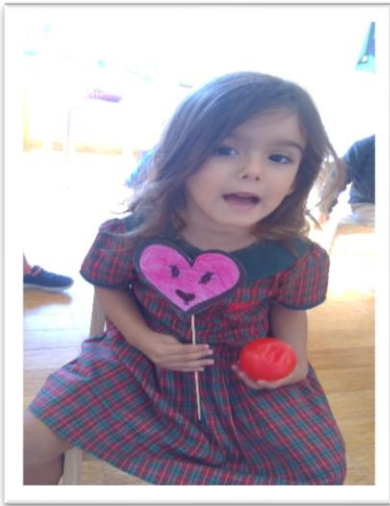
