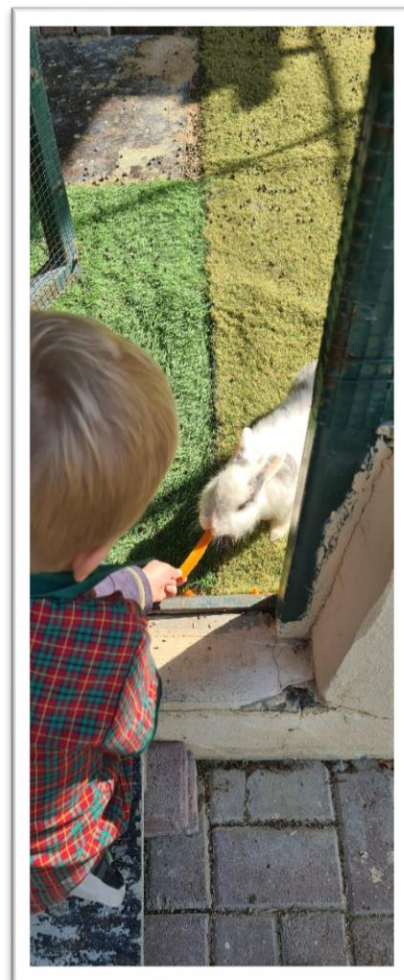
UNIT OF INQUIRY

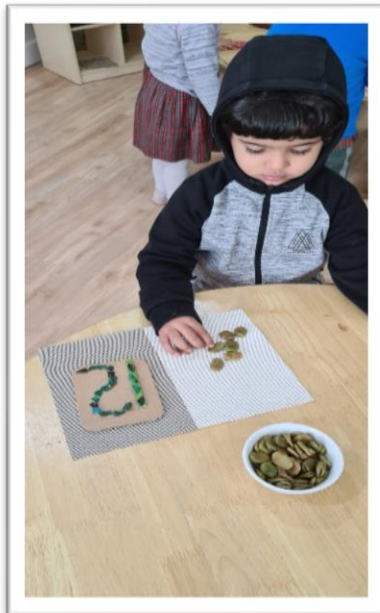
LITERACY

MATHS

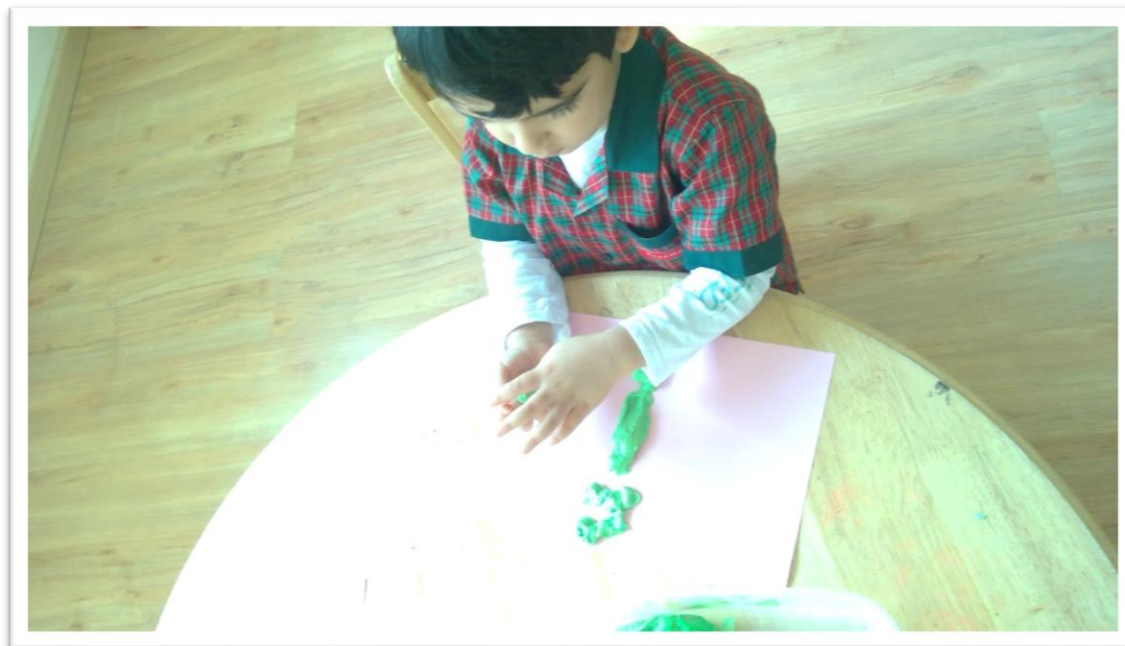
