
Reminders/Upcoming Events

UNIT OF INQUIRY

This term has been "Our Environment". We have discussed topics such as Recycling and Reusing, the importance of taking care of our planet and how each one of us can make a big difference by playing a small part.



MATHEMATICS (RECEPTION AND YEAR 1)

In Maths, the children have been working on the Part-Whole model and have now started to match the model with equations. They have done a fantastic job with their additions and subtractions so far.

We will continue to work on number bonds to 10 and 20 using the Part-Whole model.

WELLBEING (RECEPTION AND YEAR 1)

We have been discussing the different feelings each one of us has, as well as things and people who make us feel safe.

FRENCH (RECEPTION AND YEAR 1)

LITERACY (RECEPTION AND YEAR 1)

In English, the children have been learning about Everyday Poems. They have been working on alliterations, rhyming words and reading with expressions. Group 1 has now started to work on adjectives and verbs while Group 2 has been working on recognising and sounding out digraphs such as ng, oa, sh and ch.

Group 1 will continue to work on mastering their knowledge of Nouns, Verbs and Adjectives while Group 2 will continue to focus on recognising, sounding out and writing words with the different digraphs.



ARABIC (RECEPTION AND YEAR 1)

We learned the letters ا ب ت ث ج ح خ. We can now write the letters as well as define things that start with the characters. As you can see from the photographs, we have had a lot of fun singing Huruf. Next month we will be learning Arabic pronunciation and how to recognize different genders and objects.

GLOBAL SKILLS (RECEPTION AND YEAR 1)

The children wrote some amazing recipes after we discussed the food they like and dislike. We have also been talking about how important it is to be kind to not just our friends but also animals.
