They love welcoming each other to school every morning and are all extremely comfortable.

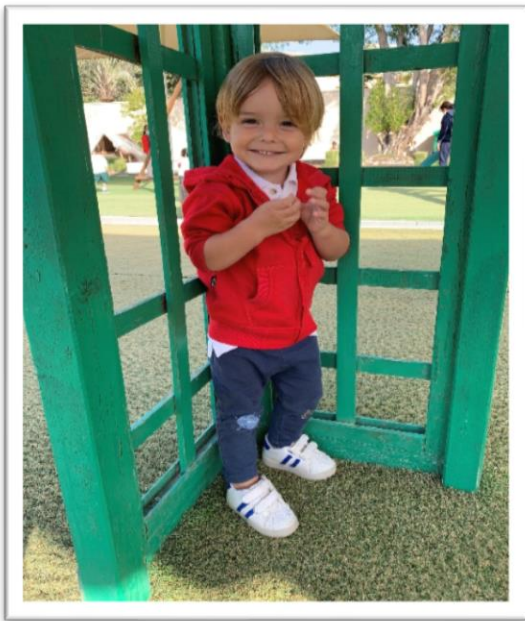
The children have gotten really good at sorting colours and are even beginning to do it with their Arabic Teacher, Ms. Fatima.
